Notice of 2012 Republican Precinct Caucuses (Updated January 28, 2012)

The 2012 Island County Republican Party Precinct Caucuses will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Saturday, March 3, 2012, at the following three locations (there is no fee for admission):

1. Lost Lake Club House on Camano Island – Registered voters residing in one of the 18 precincts located on Camano Island will convene for a pooled caucus at the Lost Lake Club House, 1469 Lake Drive, Camano Island;
2. Oak Harbor High School on North Whidbey Island – Registered voters residing in one of the 40 precincts located on North Whidbey Island will convene for a pooled caucus in the Student Union Building at Oak Harbor High School, 1 Wildcat Way, Oak Harbor; and,
3. South Whidbey High School on South Whidbey Island – Registered voters residing in one of the 25 precincts located on South Whidbey Island will convene for a pooled caucus in the New Commons Room at South Whidbey High School, 5675 Maxwellton Road, Langley.

On Whidbey Island the dividing line is generally the Naval Outlying Field, located two miles southeast of Coupeville. Central (#004), Prairie (#020) and all other precincts on the North Whidbey side of the Naval Outlying Field will caucus at Oak Harbor High School. Admiralty 1 (#033), North Bluff (#062) and all other precincts on the South Whidbey side of the Naval Outlying Field will caucus at South Whidbey High School. http://www.islandcountygop.org/uploads/2/9/5/8/2958060/2012_republican_caucuses_-_whidbey_island_dividing_line_map.pdf shows the dividing line between those four precincts.

After consideration of resolutions and the Island County Republican Party platform, the pooled caucuses will adjourn to individual precinct caucuses for the election of delegates and alternates to the 2012 Island County Republican Party Convention. The convention will be held on March 24, 2012, at Oak Harbor High School.

Any registered voter of the precinct in which the caucus is being conducted who is willing to state by signing registration forms that he/she considers him/herself to be a Republican and has not participated and will not participate in the 2012 caucus or convention system of any other party shall be eligible to participate in the caucus.
